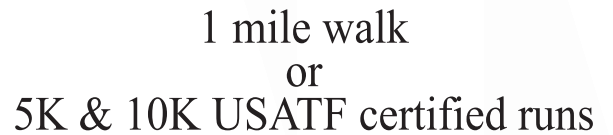

1 Mile Walk at 9:45 a.m.

Arrive early to collect bib#, t-shirt and transponder chips.
